



Offering multiple options can be advantageous to allowing a pair to choose their nest box. Nest box material selection can even be based on where the location of the box is. (Off exhibit, on exhibit)

If your parrots are known to be very destructive a PVC box or wood nest box may not be suitable or wood.

Metal Nest boxes PROS CONS Virtually indestructible. Easy to clean Durable and great longevity. Not natural looking if used on exhibit. Eliminates natural behavior to chew or excavate the nest box.

Metal is often difficult to work with> constructing

Generally metal boxes can be used breeding season after breeding season.



Wood boxes allow for multiple options for nest box shapes.

A lot of the time wood boxes have to repaired or replaced after each breeding season. Can be painted or camouflaged to blend in an exhibit.

PVC Nest boxes PROS Easy to build and install. Easy to clean and disinfect. Durable and long lasting. Parrots can't chew and excavate. PVC retains moisture which can cause issues. PVC can be expensive especially the larger dimensions.

PVC is easy to work with.

PVC is not for parrots that are really big chewers!!!

PVC has worked well for breeding Galah's at Sedgwick County Zoo



Logs and Barrels

PROS

- Naturalistic.
- Allows for natural chewing and excavating.
- Durable and long lasting.

CONS

Large and heavy, can be difficult to install.
