In the Beginning or...

the King and Al

- King Penguin "Tut" SWSD
 - ► Long term study to collect, store, freeze semen
 - ► Cooperative participant
- Magellanic:
 - ► Cooperative participants
 - ► Easy to isolate female
- Success (8 chicks)
 - ▶ 2013: 4 via chilled semen Al
 - ▶ 2014: 3 via chilled semen AI and 1 chick conceived from frozen semen



Why...Al?

- Long term diversity
 - ► Increase number of pairs goals
 - ▶ Genetic
 - Sustainability of populations
 - ► Potential application for endangered populations
 - Genome banking



When you get back, tell your hotshot scientist that we've been reproducing with frozen sperm and eggs for years!"

Blood work

- ► Blood:
 - ▶ 8 ml in a lithium-heparin tube placed on ice
 - ► Jugular vein blood samples
 - ~5 weeks prior to egg lay to study biology determine egg laying/oviposition
 - Nest were fenced off based on hormone and biochemistry values
- ► Fecal samples:
 - ▶ Difficult to obtain
 - ▶ Ideal less invasive
 - ► Reduce (replace blood samples)




Nesting

- Outdoor exhibit
 - ► Natural setting
 - ▶ Palm logs, perching, browse to cover
 - Cut Pampas grass distributed in exhibit


Boys on guard: Males visual access to females





Collection

- Samples were collect day before
- ► Chilled for ~20 hours
- Next day females inseminated
- ► Teaser sits with clean towel on lap
- Clean cloaca with gauze and cleaning medium
- ► Timing of collection



Collection



- Male away from or adjacent to nest
- ► Towels used to support males
- ► Two people:
 - ► Collector and a teaser
- Collector
 - ► Clean cloaca
 - ► Collection cup

- Monitor for 10 minutes post insemination
- Watch for urination/defecation when bird wakes up
